## Parent/Student Contract

***Student, please initial each line to show that you understand and agree to each rule and responsibility.***

As a **student** of this program, I agree to the following:

- \_\_\_\_\_ I will comply with the current Chesapeake Public Schools *Student Conduct Policy Guidelines Handbook*.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will dress according to the dress code. (Please refer to the *CCSS Dress Code*.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that cell phones and other electronic devices must be turned off prior to exiting the bus and turned in to staff upon entering the building.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will attend every minute of every class, every day.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will actively participate in my classes by listening, working, and following procedures and directives as outlined by the teacher (s).
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will complete all classwork and homework assignments.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will follow the rules and responsibilities outlined in the *Student Conduct Policy Guidelines Handbook* when riding the school bus.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I am responsible for showing my parent/guardian my daily score card and returning it signed.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the only time I am allowed on the property of any other school is while changing buses. If I am found to be on any school's property, for any reason, without the permission of Mr. Brown, I will be charged with trespassing.

***Parent/Guardian, please initial each line to show that you understand and agree to each requirement.***

### **Attendance**

- \_\_\_\_\_ If my child is absent, it is my responsibility to provide a written excuse within 4 days of the absence.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If my child is absent for more than 5 consecutive days, it is my responsibility to request and coordinate the picking up of make-up work by contacting the school at **757-578-7046**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If I bring my child to school, or have them brought to school by another individual, I/they must accompany him/her to the security desk and sign him/her in.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **High School Only:** I understand that if my student misses 9 days in any given class, he/she automatically fails the course, will not receive credit, and will be required to repeat the course.

### **Behavior**

- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I may be required to attend meetings in reference to Child Study, IEP, behavior, truancy, suspensions, suspension reinstatement, or a parent/teacher conference. Refer to **VA Code 22.1-279.3**; *Student Conduct Policy Guidelines Handbook*.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I will review my student's score card and sign it daily.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my child is suspended from riding the school bus, I will be responsible for transporting my child to and from school.
- \_\_\_\_\_ I am aware that Chesapeake Center for Student Success offers the services of a guidance Counselor and other intervention specialists.

**Course Performance**

\_\_\_\_\_ I am aware that **ParentVUE**, the online student information program, is available to review my child's academic progress.

**Dress Code**

\_\_\_\_\_ I will supply my child with a clean white shirt, pants (blue/black/khaki) or long shorts (no holes, rips, or tears), a belt, and appropriate shoes to attend school.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my child is in violation of the Chesapeake Alternative School dress code, he/she will not be allowed to attend classes until they are in compliance. (Refer to pg. 14 of the *Chesapeake Alternative School Handbook*.)

**Electronic Devices**

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that my child's cell phone and other electronic devices must be turned off prior to exiting the bus and turned in to staff upon entering the building.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my child brings more than one cell phone to school it will be confiscated and I will have to come to school and sign for the item in order to receive it back.

**Cash**

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if my child brings any money to school, cash or coin, any denomination, that it will be confiscated. In order to receive the money back, I will have to come into school and sign for it in order for it to be returned. **High School Only:** I understand that it may be necessary for students to carry cash on their person in the event of an *emergency*. Money should remain in pockets throughout class sessions. *Excessive* amounts of cash will be confiscated and inventoried. In order to receive the money back, I will have to come into the school and sign for it in order for money to be returned.

**Transportation**

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand the my child is required to follow the rules and responsibilities outlined in the *Student Conduct Policy Guidelines Handbook* when riding the school bus.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that if I am not available to pick up my child due to a dress code violation or other discipline issue that requires immediate attention, I am responsible for arranging alternate transportation for him/her in a timely manner.

**Trespassing**

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand that the only time my student is allowed on the property of any other school is while changing buses. If my student is found to be on any school's property, for any reason, without the permission of Mr. Brown, they will be charged with trespassing.
