

Student Handbook Sign-Off Form

- Program Overview - how to move up, how to complete the program, things that will move you down in the program (bus referrals, not meeting goal, etc.)
- Being prepared for class – materials needed, score card signed daily, etc.
- Homework
- Cell phones/phone calls – only one cell phone permitted, we do not pull kids from class for phone calls, if more than one cell phone then phone will be confiscated
- Medications – do you need to see/talk to the school nurse, medications must be transported by parent only, doctor's order required
- Attendance – must bring notes within 4 days, unexcused absences (missing bus, not waking up, etc.), students in 9th grade will not receive credit if they miss more than 9 days
- Parent pick-up – must be here by 3 p.m., cannot call early unless a medical or dental appointment
- Truancy
- Make-up work for absences
- Cash – no money needed, all money will be confiscated and only be returned if parent picks up
- Leaving/returning during school day – please try to make appointments either first thing in the morning or later in the afternoon. If this can't be avoided, a student can come to school, be picked up for an appointment, and return. Having a mid-day appointment doesn't mean the student needs to miss the entire school day.
- Dress code – requirements, penalties for violation
- Food/snacks – only complete lunches can be brought (not just chips and soda)
- Bus regulations
- Cafeteria – everyone gets free breakfast and lunch
- Discipline
- Transitions
- Trespassing – students can be charged with trespassing if on another school's property without permission or are roaming during bus transitions
- Professional Tuesdays
- Phone and internet policy
- Police – resource officer on duty at the school. He does wear a camera and in the event of a disturbance the student(s) may be recorded. Be aware of what is occurring on student's social media accounts. Letters from the police department enclosed.
- Art therapy (enrollment packet) – signed permission slip
- Sheriff's mentoring program (enrollment packet) – signed slip for after-school mentoring opportunities
