**GUIDE TO HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER PROGRAMS 2022**

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

High school summer school classes will be offered online and in-person.

- GFH: students from GFH, GBH, HHS, and IRH
- WBH: Students from DCH, OSH, and WBH

The high school summer learning program is designed to offer opportunities for students to repeat courses not successfully completed during the regular school year and afford students opportunities to remain on track with their graduation cohort. **All classes are dependent on sufficient enrollment and the availability of qualified and appropriately endorsed instructional staff.**

**REGISTRATION**

Students should contact their school counselor for help in the registration process. Early registration is strongly encouraged. CPS students may register for summer school courses beginning **May 13, 2022** through the home schools counseling department. Registration should be completed by **Friday, June 10, 2022**, at each student's home school. Please note that summer school registrations will NOT be processed June 13th - June 20th. Summer school registration will resume on the dates and times below.

**STUDENT CONDUCT**

Appropriate student conduct is vital to ensuring a safe, orderly learning environment. Student conduct and policy guidelines for the 2021-2022 school year will remain in effect during all summer school sessions. Courses are not self-paced and students are expected to complete a certain number of assignments each week.

**ATTENDANCE**

Chesapeake Public Schools reserves the right to drop students if they do not engage during the drop/add period.

**STANDARDS OF LEARNING (SOL)**

Students will be required to report to the summer school site to complete all required Virginia Department of Education SOL assessments in person as conditions permit.

**COURSE CHANGES**

Requests to change or drop a course must be made within the first three days of class. If a student drops a course after the first three days, the student will receive a grade of "E" as the final grade for the course dropped.

## WISE Quick Review

Optional four-day quick review sessions will be offered to CPS students who need additional assistance prior to retaking the WISE Financial Literacy Test.
