

Paint Your Parking Spot Application

Requirements:

1. Seniors must purchase a parking spot from the office for the 2022-2023 school year.
2. Only seniors are eligible to paint their parking spot.
3. **Seniors must have their design approved by Mrs. Collins.**
3. Students may only paint in their assigned and approved parking spot, **keeping white lines visible.**
4. Students must provide their own paint, and that **paint must be approved when checking in on the Paint Days. Please use only exterior flat latex paint.**
5. **Designs which include offensive language, pictures, drugs, or weapons references will NOT be permitted.** If you do not adhere to the above, your spot will be commandeered and painted over, and you will lose your parking privileges for the year.
6. Scheduled Paint Days are **Saturday, August 20 (9:00AM - 12:00PM), Monday, August 22 (9:00AM - 12:00PM), Tuesday, August 23 (9:00AM - 12:00PM).**
7. If you paint your spot at any other time than the times above, it will be considered vandalism and administrative action will be taken.
8. On Paint Days, you must bring your parking spot tag with you to verify your spot. Make sure to check in with the SCA volunteers before you start painting.
9. In June of 2022, you are responsible for painting over your spot with exterior flat black paint. We will have scheduled times to do so.
10. Students must complete this application and turn it in with **\$25**. Please make checks payable to **Grassfield High School**.
