The parents of children with 5 unexcused absences must hold a conference with school personnel to discuss absences. After 7 unexcused absences, these cases must be referred to truancy court. Excessive tardiness will also be referred to truancy court. Children will be excused from school for illness and medical appointments. Vacation is not an excused absence.
