GENERAL INFORMATION

High school summer school classes will be offered online for Chesapeake Public Schools students only. Students must be enrolled in grades 8-12 during the 2020-2021 school year in order to attend. The high school summer learning program is designed to offer opportunities for students to repeat courses not successfully completed during the regular school year and afford students opportunities to remain on track with their graduation cohort. *All classes are dependent on sufficient enrollment and the availability of qualified and appropriately endorsed instructional staff.*

REGISTRATION

Students should contact their school counselor for help in the registration process. Early registration is strongly encouraged. CPS students may register for summer school courses beginning **Monday, April 26, 2021** at the school he/she regularly attends. Registration should be completed by **Tuesday, June 8, 2021** at each student's home school. On-site registration will be held at Oscar Smith High School beginning **Tuesday, June 22, 2021**.

STUDENT CONDUCT

STANDARDS OF LEARNING (SOL)

Students may be required to report to the summer school site to complete all required Virginia Department of Education tests in-person as conditions permit.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Monday, June 28, 2021 – Thursday, July 29, 2021

The Special Education Program is for students who currently receive special education services and were recommended for the program by their teacher. The program is designed to maintain the student's skill development.

English Learners (EL)

The EL program is designed for students in grades six through eight who are in the process of learning English as a second language and whose proficiency levels are 1, 2, 3 or 4. Students will work in small groups to expand vocabulary and to improve their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. World Class Instructional Design and Assessment (WIDA) standards will be covered.

COURSE CHANGES

Requests to change or drop a course must be made within the first three days of class. If a student drops a course after the first three days, the student will receive a grade of "E" as the final grade for the course dropped.

CREDIT RECOVERY

Credit Recovery

Online credit recovery courses will be available to CPS students who need to recover credit. Students may take up to two credit recovery classes during Extended Summer Learning Academies.
