

ON-CAMPUS CONTINUUM

Returning students to on-campus learning **five days per week:**

September 14

- K-12 Related Services
- K-12 English Learners (levels I & II)

Beginning the week of September 14, we plan to bring back specifically identified students at all grade levels who receive special education related services that cannot be provided virtually-- and level 1 and 2 English Learners. Transportation will be provided for students and the amount of time on campus will be determined on an individual basis.

When scheduled for services, students may need to remain on campus for additional time, up to a half day or possibly a full day, based on the transportation schedule for their assigned school. In some cases, services may not be initially provided at a student's home school. While on campus, these students will be supported by teacher assistants and other available staff so they can continue their online learning for language support and/or related services.

Students who require in person special education related services will be contacted directly by their schools and notified of their schedules.



ON-CAMPUS CONTINUUM

Returning students to on-campus learning **five days per week:**

September 21

- Special Education
- Preschool (CPI & ECSE)
- Kindergarten

Then, beginning the week of **September 21**, we plan to bring back:

- **students at all grade levels** who receive greater than 90% of their special education services in a self-contained environment
- **all** preschool students in both the Chesapeake Preschool Initiative and the Early Childhood Special Education programs, and
- **all** Kindergarten students **five days per week**.



ON-CAMPUS CONTINUUM

Returning students to on-campus learning **five days per week**:

Beginning the week of September 28, we plan to bring back all

- first,
- second, and
- third grade students **five days per week**.

Using this phased approach, we are confident we are able to return our students to on-campus learning while implementing health and safety guidelines. Please know, in order to make this transition occur, we need to remember that masks will need to be worn whenever six feet of physical distancing cannot occur. In some situations, the distance between students may be between three to six feet.

September 28

- First Grade
- Second Grade
- Third Grade



Additional Updates

- Parents must complete a daily digital health screening for students returning to campus. This will be completed in ParentVUE
- All parents & guardians must digitally sign a 2020-21 Health Screening Commitment (one time per student) before they return to campus.
- The next School Board meeting is on September 14. At this meeting, we will discuss bringing back additional student groups in the On-Campus Continuum (Option 1). Grades 4-6 are our next priority.
- Shifts along the On-Campus Continuum will not impact the instruction of students enrolled in Chesapeake Online (Option 2). The students enrolled in Option 2 will remain online all semester and can elect to remain online for the entire school year if they so choose.
- Please remember, this schedule is subject to change as we continue to monitor health metrics closely.
