MEALS ARE NO COST TO STUDENTS

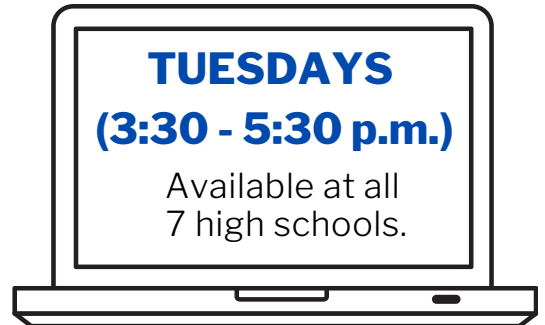
Free meals continue this school year for all students. All schools provide both breakfast and lunch.

Beginning with the September 21, 2021, curbside distribution, parents are asked to preorder meals through MyPaymentsPlus.com.

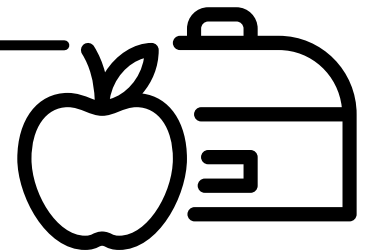


ALLERGY CONCERNS

LUNCH BUDDY MEAL PROGRAM

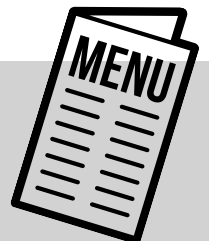
NO COST FOR SIDE ITEMS!

Establishes eligibility for free or reduced price on school meals. Also used as a qualifier for many pandemic benefits such as Pandemic EBT.



SPORTS FEES

Reduced fees for sports and activities

Discount fees for home internet



TEST FEES

Discount on fees for AP exams and waived fees for SAT/ACT testing.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Local scholarships, tuition assistance for dual enrollment courses and discount fees on applying for college.

Meal applications can also help school budgets by increasing state and federal funding for staff, equipment and supplies.
