“All That Glitters Is GOLD”

- All floats must pertain to the **Glitter/GOLD Theme** theme.
- Our game rivals are the **Nansemond River High School**.
- All floats must face the passenger side of the truck.
- Floats may not exceed one level. No multi-level floats allowed.
- Trailers may not exceed twenty feet in length. All entries must be able to fit through the stadium gates.
- Floats will be judged on the criteria stated below.
- ~~• The top 3 winning floats will participate in a Pre-game parade inside the stadium.~~
- ~~• Banners or floats from each grade level will participate in the Pre-game parade.~~
- **Everyone entering the stadium with the winning floats must purchase a game ticket to enter.**
- No one will be allowed to exit the stadium and re-enter.
