On Monday, we will begin contacting families of high school students who need devices, giving priority to seniors. Impacted students will be contacted to schedule an appointment. Our staff continues to provide meals each weekday at no cost to anyone 18 and under at sixteen different meal distribution sites across the City. As a reminder, it is vital that families practice physical distancing when visiting these sites to ensure the safety of all involved. We would like to thank the Chesapeake Police Department for their assistance at these locations as we continue to serve our school community throughout the closure.

Our schools and offices remain closed, but we will continue to serve our school community by conducting essential business remotely.
